St Joseph's RC Primary School, Wetherby: St Joseph's has no kitchen which means that their meals are delivered into school hot from another nearby local primary school, Crossley Street Primary, Leeds. Many people assume that receiving a transported meal will result in low quality, easy meals being prepared. At St Joseph's this is not the case. The meal served in school is a Food for Life quality menu at Bronze standard and as part of this incorporates lots of fresh fruit, vegetables and meat and meals which are made from scratch locally before being delivered. As well as the focus on fresh food prepared by scratch the secret to maintaining the quality of the food between the two schools is the short distance between the two sites (less than a mile). The menu is agreed with the cook from the supply kitchen and the charge hand at St Joseph's who through regular discussion and feedback ensure that the menu on offer suits the likes and dislikes of the children in school.
